AUTHORITY IS...	PRE-INDUSTRIAL SOCIETY
DECENTRALIZED & EGALITARIAN	<p>BAND refers to a small group of related people occupying a single region</p> <p>TRIBE refers to a group of bands occupying a specific region, that speak a common language, share a common culture, and are integrated by some unifying factor</p>
CENTRALIZED & HIERARCHICAL	<p>CHIEFDOM refers to a ranked society in which every member has a position in the hierarchy</p> <p>STATE refers, in anthropology, to a centralized political system with the power to coerce</p>
